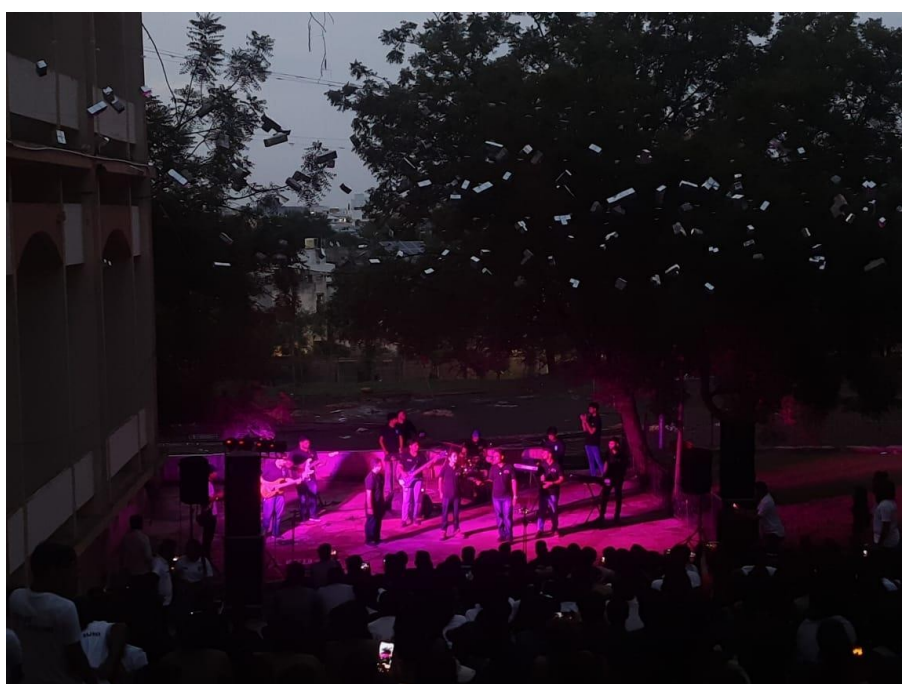


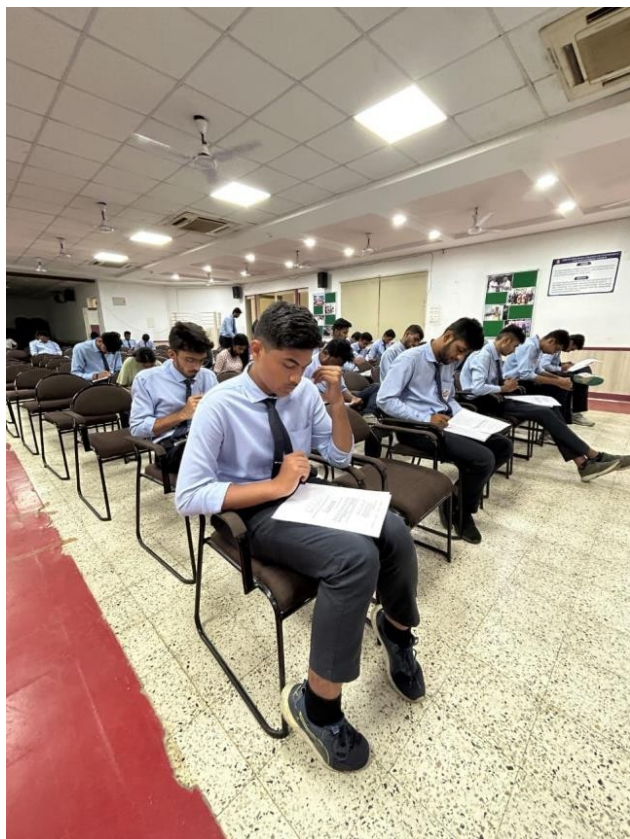
Aaruni'22



The next round was an aptitude test, followed by a group discussion round, wherein the general awareness of the students was put to test. The fourth round was a fun-filled surprise round, wherein the students took part in extempore and were tested on their abilities to act upon a situation given to them on the spot. The next and the fifth round was a personal interview round, in which the students who surpassed all the four rounds were invited. After the personal interviews, three girls and three boys were shortlisted for the final stage round which was held on 15th July 2023. The stage round was held in front of the judges who were invited, the faculty and the students.

During the week, to keep the students engaged and involved and to ensure that no one was left out of the events, numerous tasks were given, like to make up a video on a certain outline with their creative freedom and approach. Each of the tasks were evaluated and a leaderboard was made. These points were then summarized to find out the winner of the Best section task.

The final showdown of Aaruni 2022 was the **Cultural Night**. At first, the impera stage round was held in which the three finalists put their best foot forward. Following Impera rounds, the most awaited series of events began. The program kicked off with a mellifluous performance by the Music Club, succeeded by The Drama club and dance club. GYANODAYA-FIRST YEAR INDUCTION PROGRAMME


"Arise, awake, and stop not till the goal is reached"- Swami Jnanamurtyananda, at RCOEM


CHANDRAYAAN-3 AICTE EVENT

To celebrate the historic achievement of Chandrayan-3 and to value the efforts of Team ISRO, an event was organized in Shri Ramdeobaba College of Engineering & Management, Nagpur in affiliation with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) on 27th September 2023 in the Main Auditorium. SRC Members welcomed the respected faculty members of our institution and the event started with our electrified anchors for the event Ms. Rishika Kumar and Master Ameya Brahmapurikar chanting a Sanskrit Verse.

The audience was made aware of the inside story and the emotions of the scientists by performers from Readers' Reverie Literary Club, RCOEM. At first, Master Vedant Suryawanshi gave an overview of Chandrayan-3 which created immense interest among the audience. Later he moved his focus toward the History of ISRO where he mentioned how small parts of rockets were carried on bicycles; which made the audience understand how far we have come. Secondly, Ms. Veena Jawrani spoke as an ISRO Scientist associated with Chandrayan-1. Achievements and findings were highlighted during her speech. Now, the 3rd speaker Ms. Vedanti Dalvi represented Dr. Ritu Shrivastav – known as ‘Rocket Lady’ and was the Mission Director of Chandrayan-2. She gave a brief about the features of the Chandrayan-2 Mission and its objectives. She even threw light on how the Mission failed and what went wrong. She thanked her family for their support during those tough times. She also talked about the heartfelt situation of the entire team and Dr. K. Sivan, but the faith our Honourable Prime Minister and the entire nation showed; gave them courage to stand strong. Now, the next speaker Master Siddhant Mishra spoke as the Chairman of ISRO Dr. S. Somnath. He enlightened the audience with the failure-based learning approach they adopted for Chandrayan-3. He even talked about the potential findings ISRO will get and the importance of those findings. Later, he thanked all those who contributed to the success of Chandrayan-3 and even expressed his gratitude towards the citizens of India for their love and support. The 5th and the last performer was Ms. Advika Metre. She spoke as a common man and very smartly identified life lessons from all the previous speeches. Qualities like perseverance and time management are what we can learn from ISRO. The importance of unity and collaboration was also discussed. She ended the speech by citing a quote by A. P. J. Abdul Kalam which created a special place in the heart of the audience.

The audience was taken on a space exploration journey without fastening their seatbelts, by a wonderful video that had visuals from the mission and was full of knowledge and facts. The video had various short clips ranging from the making of a rocket to the Pragyan Rover moving on the moon. Everyone was amazed by the inside visuals from the control centres which proved how challenging the task is. Discoveries from all the Chandrayan Missions were told which made the audience aware of the significant findings our scientists have achieved. When the video of the ISRO Chairman happily saying ‘India is on the Moon’ was screened, no one could stop from giving a round of applause. The ISRO Chairman strongly and loudly told the world the power of ‘New India’ and the talent our nation possesses.



This gave a clear motivation to all aspiring scientists from our institute to make India proud in the future. Actual images and videos from the moon's surface developed interest among the audience.

After so much knowledge, it was time for our talented musicians from Music Club, RCOEM to showcase India's glory through music. Performance on 'जयोस्तुते' made the entire environment full of patriotism and respect for our freedom fighters as well as our scientists for their tremendous efforts. The next song 'ये जो देश है तेरा' depicted how great our nation is. It appealed to the people to stay in India and contribute to its development and well-being.

As a surprise element for the audience, a quiz was conducted to test their 'Chandrayan ka Gyaan' based on Chandrayan-3.

Date : 21st October 23



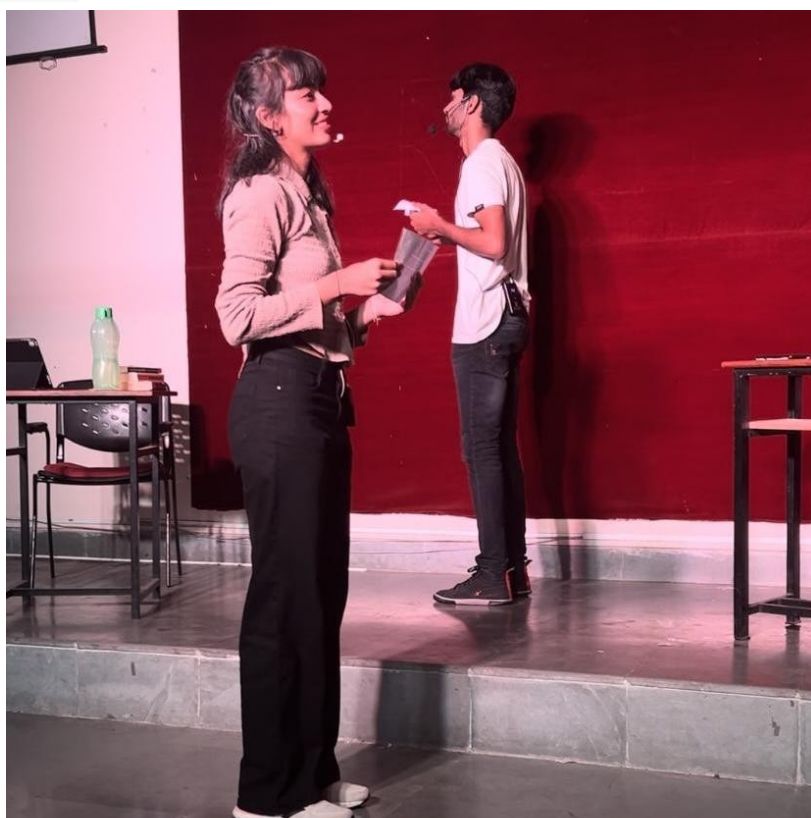

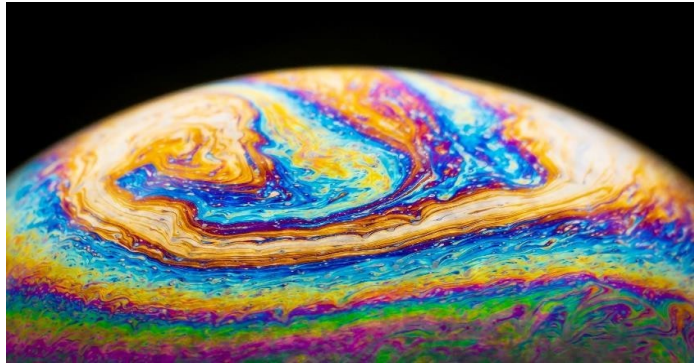
The host for the event were Mr. Tanmay Telmasre and Mr. Nimish Chitlange and the cup was managed by other members of student Representative Council.

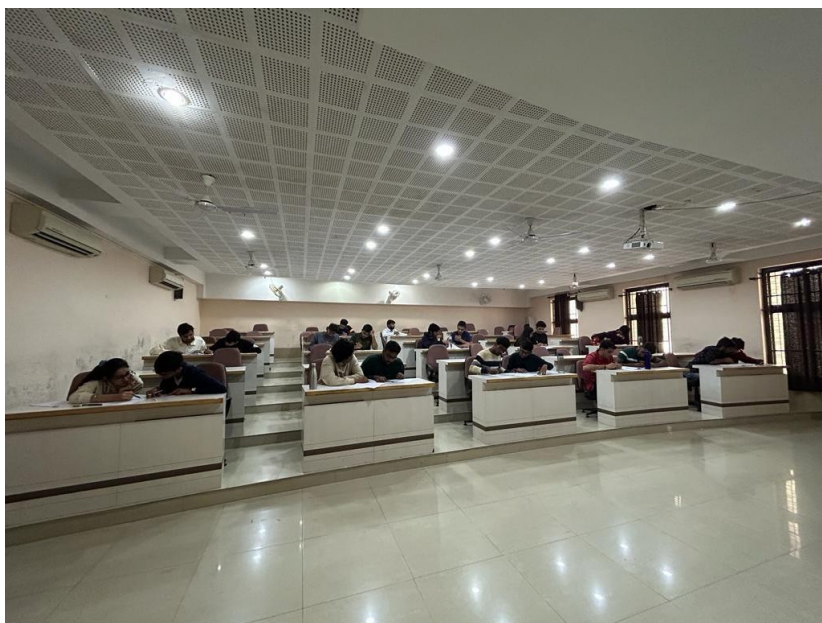

The Students' Representative Council successfully organized the Technical Cup on 23/01/2024 & 24/01/2024 respectively. All the branches of the college were eligible to compete in this competition. The Technical Cup consisted of three rounds – Aptitude Test, Technical Test, and Smart Branch Hackathon.

On Day-1, 23rd January 2024, round 1 was conducted first in which 60 minutes were given to two participants of each team to solve the Aptitude Test together. Round 2 was Technical Test where 40 minutes were given to the other two participants of the team to solving coding question on an online platform. The technical test had 2 subparts: Coding questions and Error solving questions.

On Day-2, 24th January 2024, Topics for Smart Branch Hackathon were given to the participants 3 days prior to the competition date. Here they have to prepare a presentation that contains a complete solution of Problem statement that was given to them. Participants were given 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for Q&A round with judge. The judge for the afternoon was Mr. Bhavesh Bhaisare Sir, who was the former Technical Incharge of SRC 2021- 22 and was also a member of Technical Club and Robotics and Aviation Club.

The Dance Cup had the following three categories as follows:

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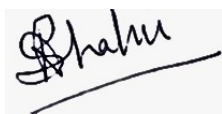
Round 1: Trio	Thematic Dance	3 min
