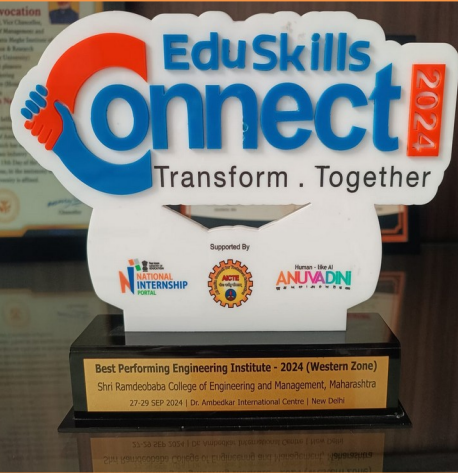

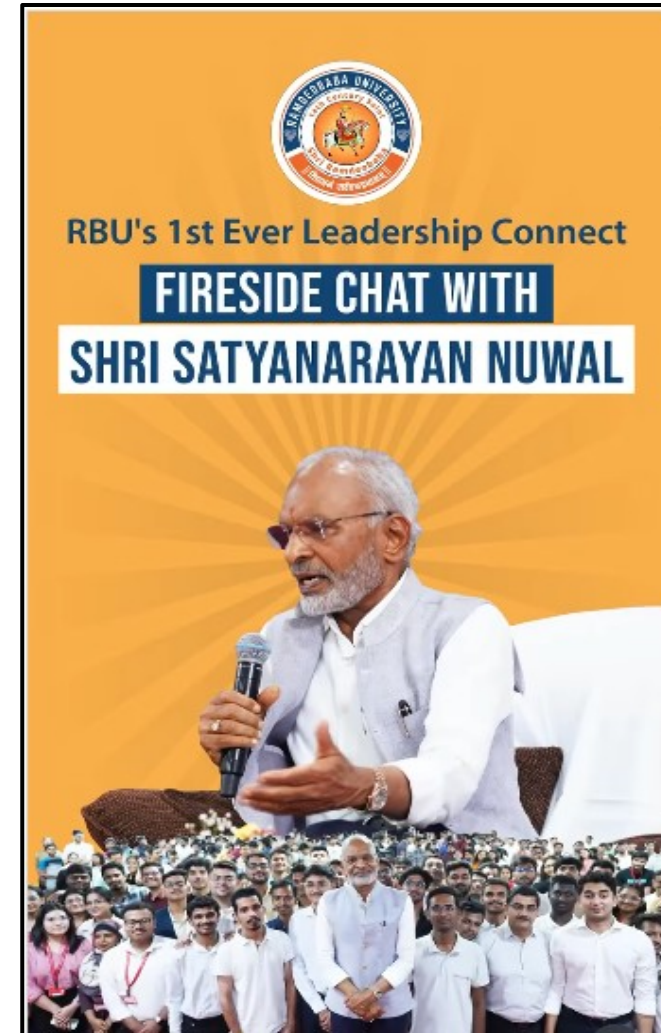

Choose morality over success, states Satyanarayan Nuwal

Chairman of Solar Group delivers inspiring speech at Ramdeobaba University

"Success and morality should go hand in hand. However, if ever faced with a choice between the two, always choose morality over success," advised Satyanarayan Nuwal, founder and chairman of Solar Industries India Limited, the country's leading defence and explosives manufacturing company. He was speaking to students of Ramdeobaba University (RBU) during the university's inaugural fireside chat under its newly launched 'Leadership Connect' initiative. The session provided students with a rare opportunity to engage directly with a prominent industry leader and get a rare glimpse

into the journey of a first-generation entrepreneur who rose from modest beginnings to head a global enterprise. Nuwal emphasised the importance of transparency and integrity in company policies and systems

'Failures and hard work are real ingredients of success'

When asked about the secrets of his success, Nuwal credited it to enduring numerous failures, several mistakes and putting in relentless hard work. "To achieve success, one must be willing to face setbacks and work hard consistently," he remarked.

Stay ahead with technology

"At present, being technologically advanced is non-negotiable. One must continuously upgrade and adapt to stay relevant in the industry," said Satyanarayan Nuwal. He emphasized that a technology learned today could be outdated by next year, and thus it's essential to keep learning and evolving.

- Goals at 20: "I underwent vocational training at Gayatri Purbari Hindustan to learn from ink-making to printing press skills. My only goal was business."
- Biggest challenge: "After becoming India's largest explosives trader, convincing people I could manufacture for India's defence was hard. But I saw potential. 70% of our defence imports could be made here."
- Key management lessons: "Credibility, competency, and the ability to unite everyone."
- Leadership tip: "Transparent policies - across vendors, employees, and customers."
- Advice for budding entrepreneurs: "Step outside your comfort zone. No shortcuts to hard work."
- He also emphasized: "Kutatanaay Panshaya - A man becomes what he thinks."
- His golden mantra: "Always choose morality over success. Identify problems, grab opportunities, and stay grounded."

Centre allocates Rs 27,300 cr for railway infra upgradation in State

CENTRAL Government has allocated Rs 27,300 crore for State of Maharashtra to upgrade the rail infrastructure as part of vision of next 50 years. Giving the breakthrough a media interaction, Railway Minister Ashwin Vaishnav on Friday, said, the allocation is one of the highest in recent years and in next two to three years, travellers would notice the change in the way they travel with Indian Railways. The focus, apart from augmentation of railway tracks, is on enhancement of facilities at railway stations.

Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis was also present during the media interaction.

that was held at Mumbai. Fadnis said, under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership, about Rs 1.73 lakh crore has been infused in Maharashtra rail infrastructure in last 10 years compared to mere Rs 10,000 lakh crore of combined investment in State during Congress-led UPA Government's rule. Giving description of the railway projects, the Railway Minister said that of the important projects is development of Hadapsar Depot at Pune which is part of augmentation of capacity in major cities of country. This project will help in increasing number of services to Pune that is now major centre of education and IT.

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"credibility, capability and competency" Addressing aspiring entrepreneurs, he encouraged them to seize every opportunity and remain open to learning from both mistakes and failures.

When asked about his entry into the defense sector, Nuwal explained that a strong defense is essential for any nation aiming to be self-reliant, alongside economic and technological progress. "India's dependency on defense imports motivated me to contribute to this sector," he said adding that despite many advising him against it, he chose to pursue the path nonetheless.

He also recounted his early journey, his education, initial failures, and the various challenges he faced. He shared how he moved from Rajasthan to Bal-

arshah and then to Chandrapur, each step taken with renewed energy and focus on realising the dream he had envisioned in his teenage years: to build a successful business.

RBU Vice-Chancellor Dr. Rajesh Pande, in his welcome address, described Nuwal as a person who exemplifies the "Human Excellence Quotient, Self-Learning Quotient, Lifelong Learning Quotient, and Intelligence Quotient," core values that RBU aims to instill in its students. The event was attended by General Secretary (SRSS) Rajendra Purohit, Nuwal's grandson Raghav Nuwal, Dr. Rajiv Khare, Dr. Rupesh Pais, and Dr. Manoj Chandak (Principal, RCOEM).
