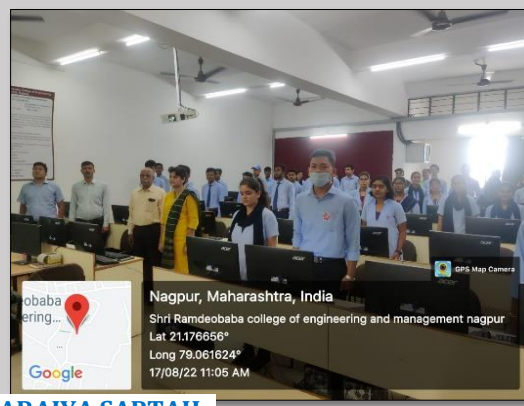

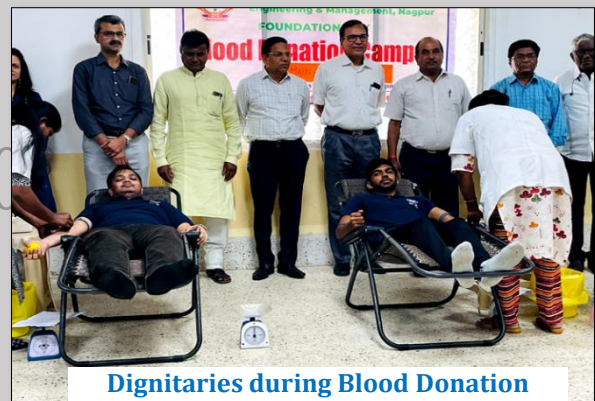

In conclusion, the Clothes Donation Drive organized by the NSS Unit of RCOEM College showcased the collective effort and generosity of the college community.



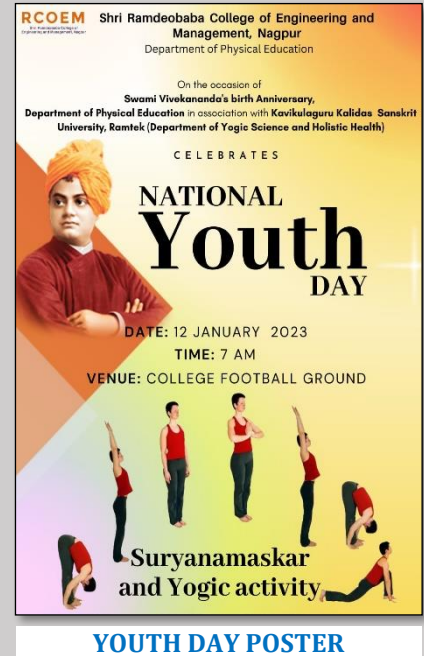

12TH JANUARY 2023

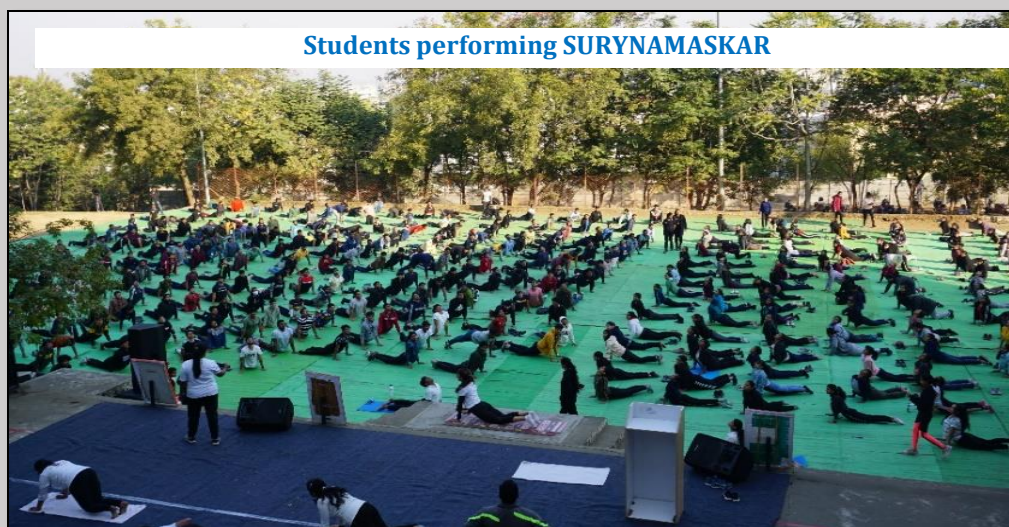

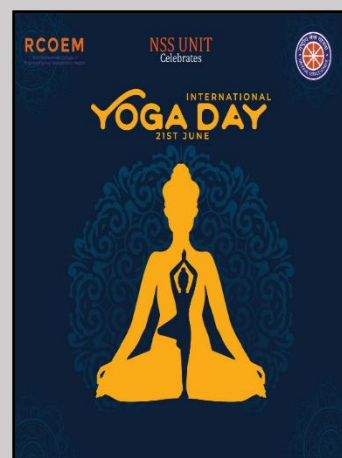
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INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA (IDY 2023)

HOUSE OF LAWS

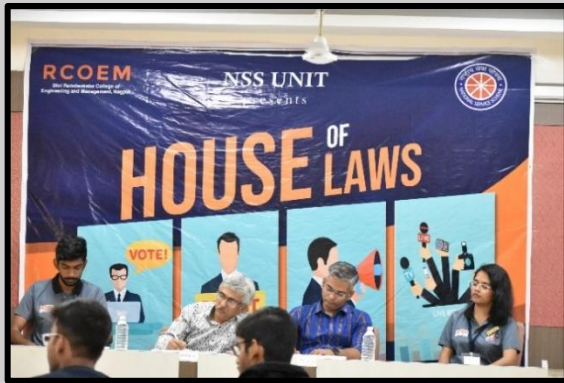
Date: 24/01/2023 and 25/01/23

"Democracy is not just voting for your leaders; it's really premised upon ordinary citizens understanding the issues."

To make this true, the NSS Unit of Shri Ramdeobaba College of Engineering and Management took the initiative to introduce Indian democracy and its laws to engineering students through "House of Laws", an event organized under Prerna 15.0. The event stretched over two days and consisted over four rounds, each based on a pillar of democracy. A total of 17 teams participated in the event. Each team comprised 4 participants.

The first round was based on the first pillar of democracy, i.e., **'The Executive'**. This round was conducted in two phases. For phase 1, every team was given a legal reasoning-based question paper. Phase 2 was a buzzer round in which teams were asked questions based on history, geography, politics, current affairs, economics, science and technology. The participants displayed great enthusiasm in this round. A total of 14 teams qualified for the next round (second), which was based on the second pillar of democracy, i.e., **'The Judiciary'**. In this round, each team was allocated a hypothetical case and was asked to research and debate with the opponent team. The judge for this round was **Adv. Neeraj Jawade**, a criminal lawyer currently working as a Special public prosecutor for the State of Maharashtra. The teams were judged on the basis of their communication skills, knowledge of laws, body language and arguments made during the court proceedings. This was followed by the third round, which was again based on a pillar of democracy, **'The Legislature'**. A total of 12 teams competed in this round, with each team eyeing a spot in the finale. In this, the teams were divided into groups of 3 and each group was asked to discuss a government scheme in a parliamentary manner. The judges for the round were **Dr. Yogesh Pandey (Assistant Professor, Mechanical Department)** and **Dr. S.R. Kulkarni (Assistant Professor, Mechanical Department)**.

The final round was based on the fourth pillar of democracy - **'The Media'**. In this round, the 4 qualifying teams were expected to answer the questions of the opponent teams as well as the audience. The questions asked were based on the government schemes allotted in the previous round. The chief guests for the final round were - Mr. Anand Manjarkhede (Visiting Professor), Mr. Arshad Tanvir Khan (Visiting Professor) and Prof. Jambuwant Shrawankar (Assistant Professor, EDT Department). The top three teams who were selected as winners were awarded with gift hampers. The event was then concluded by Mr. Karan Kapoor (NSS Volunteer). 19 Volunteers and 185 Participants made this event a grand success.

This year, the NSS Unit of Shri Ramdeobaba College of Engineering and Management, Nagpur organized "PRAYAS", under PRERNA 15.0. It was a time-limited event with government financing to empower youth, where all the participants were given problem statements based on the real-world problems to boost their problem-solving and innovation skills. The event stretched over three days and consisted of three rounds. Around 18 teams of four participants each participated in the event along with 14 NSS Volunteers who contributed in making this event a success.

The first round of PRAYAS, the '**Elevator pitch**' was conducted on 21st January. In this round, the teams were given 45-60 mins to prepare a creative format or tool to pitch their ideas. HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP

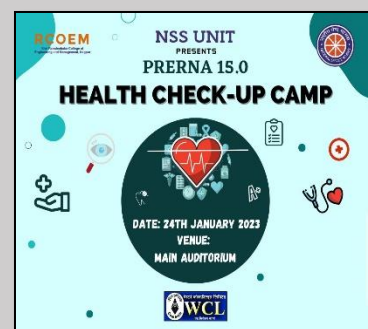
