In the quiz, there were 25 questions on Computer fundamentals, Computer Programming, Aptitude, and data structures. In coding, there was only one problem statement. The problem statement had 5 test cases to be solved in any one from C, C++, Java, or Python computer language. In the second section of the technical event, The gaming round were conducted with everyone participating on an individual level, gaming for boys and girls was conducted separately with boys playing Call of Duty: Mobile and girls playing Subway Surfer. The Winner / Highest Scorer of the Aptitude and coding section was Musharraf Mehmood Shah (1st-year 2nd-shift). - In conclusion, Mr. Gattewar provided valuable insights, including the distinction between being inspired by something and actively pursuing it, the significance of acquiring domain skills, gaining experience through hands-on involvement, and the importance of utilizing freedom with limitations for personal growth and success.
- Mr. Sumeet Gattewar's lecture provided enlightening, inspiring the students to foster innovation, cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset, and seize current opportunities.
- The Head of the Computer Application Department, Dr. P. S. Voditel, spoke about the development of a completely holistic personality.
