MCA WAD'22

(20TH DEC – 22ND DEC 2022)

A three-day workshop on aptitude development MCA WAD'22, was conducted for the students by the Department of Computer Applications from 20th December to 22nd December 2022. A total of 193 students attended the workshop.

Sessions on various topics like Interpersonal Communication, Language Comprehension in English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning/ Group Discussion, Personal Interview Techniques, Resume Writing and Vedic Mathematics were conducted by invited experts. Daily aptitude tests were also conducted for all the participants, along with events like “Extempore” and “Ad-making” in which active participation of students was also observed.

Day-1 activities

On day-1, 20th Dec 2022, all registered students were given the student kits. The aptitude tests were conducted between 8:45 – 9:45 am for the first group of students. The expert sessions began from 10:00 am. onward. The day-1 sessions were conducted by Mr. Vinay Chawla, Mr. Hitesh Dewani and Mr. Manmath Deshpande.

Mr. Vinay Chawla took a session called “Lets Unlock” where he encouraged the students to explore their hidden potential to excel in life. Mr. Hitesh Dewani took a session on “Personal Interview Techniques” where he discussed the ways in which students could prepare for their HR interviews. He narrated actual episodes from his live interview sessions with students which the audience enjoyed thoroughly and, in the process, also learnt about dos and don'ts of an interview. Mr. Manmath Deshpande made the students practice problem solving through analytical reasoning. He also made them solve examples related to quantitative aptitude.

In the evening after tea, aptitude sessions for few groups were conducted from 4:15 – 6:00 pm. The remaining groups' students participated in the extempore event and Ad-making competition.

Day-2 activities

The day began by conduction of aptitude tests for the remaining group of students from 8:45 – 10:00 am. At 10:30 am, Mr. Prantik Banerjee took a session on Competitive English: “How to add bark and bite to what you say”. He stressed on correctness of spoken and written English and gave numerous examples on how students commit common mistakes. Mr. Hitesh Dewani's second session was conducted on Resume Writing and Group Discussion. Mr. Dewani highlighted the important things which needed to be included in the resume for an effective impression. He also gave important tips on group discussion. Ms. Beena Mathew delivered a session on Interpersonal Communication and English Language Comprehension. She undertook the story telling method for conveying the importance of expression in spoken English.

The resource persons from the company gave insight to the students on the work culture of their organization. They also encouraged the students to prepare for placements right from the first year itself. From 12:15– 1:30 pm, Dr. Manjiri Munje took a session on Life management in a nature positive way. She talked extensively about stress management through yoga and intake of healthy diet. She informed the gathering about various kinds of medicinal herbs which have proved to be very beneficial to humans in preventing lifestyle related diseases.

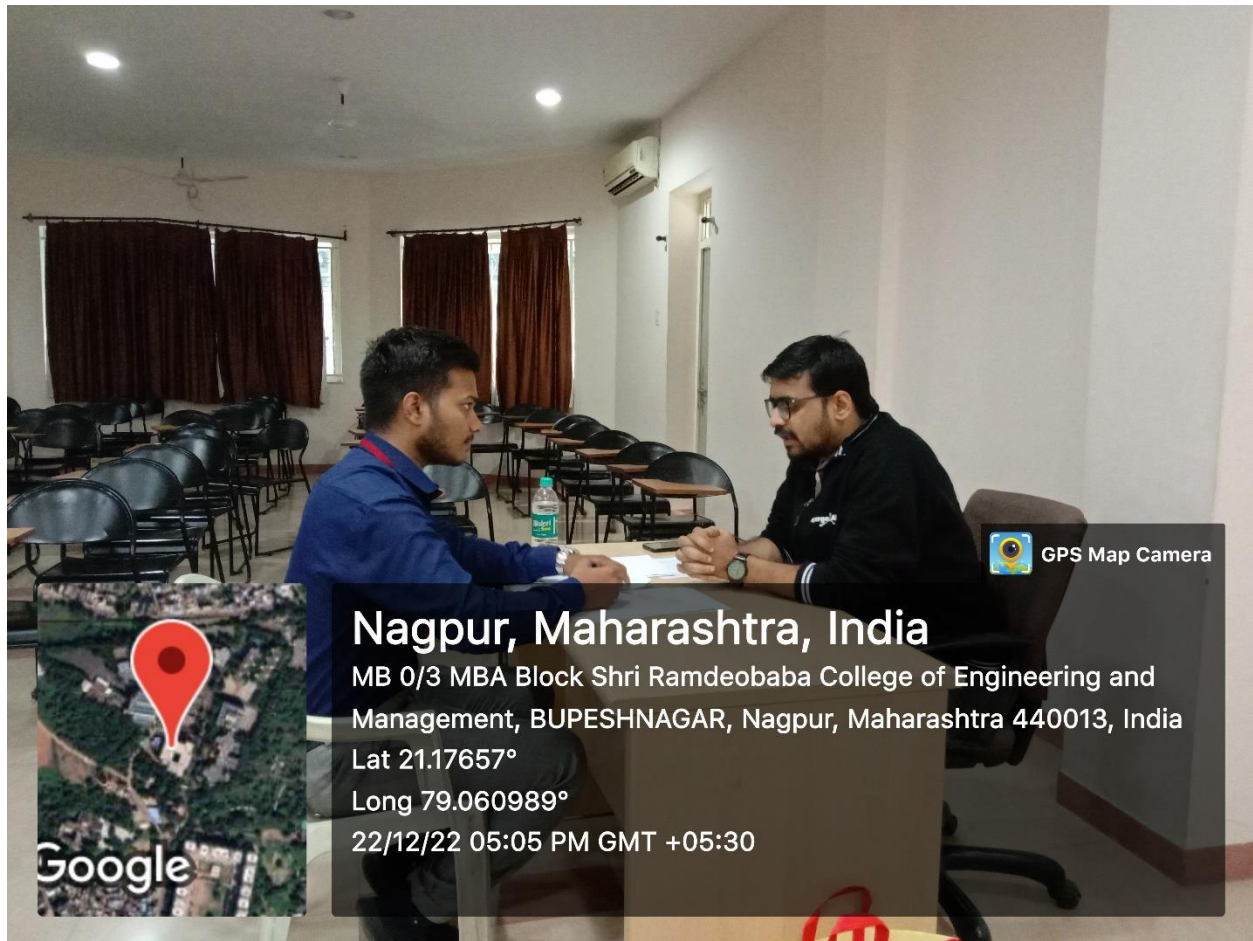
