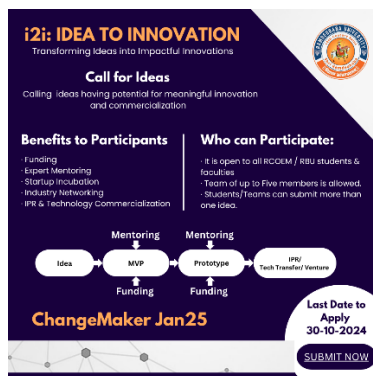
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## New Initiatives

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## i2i: Idea to Innovation Program | August 2024 Launch

The i2i: Idea to Innovation program was launched in August 2024 to support technology-driven student ideas through a structured pre-incubation journey. Over 120 ideas were received, and after a rigorous scrutiny process, the most promising concepts were selected for further mentoring toward product development. Through targeted guidance and structured evaluations, the program empowers students to transform early-stage ideas into impactful innovations, strengthening the entrepreneurial ecosystem within the university.



## Chairman's Club Formation and Fireside Chat on Leadership | April 11, 2025

The *Chairman's Club* was established as an elite platform at Ramdeobaba University to foster entrepreneurial thinking and leadership exposure among selected students. Designed to facilitate informal fireside chat sessions with industry leaders, the club aims to nurture a growth-oriented mindset and inspire future innovators.



The inaugural event under the Chairman's Club featured a Fireside Chat with Shri Satyanarayanji Nuwal, Chairman and Founder of Solar Industries India Ltd., held on April 11, 2025. Over 300 students, recognized for their excellence in academics, sports, and extracurricular activities, attended the interactive session. Shri Nuwal shared his entrepreneurial journey, leadership principles, and the values behind his success, providing participants with a rare opportunity to engage directly with an industry leader and gain valuable inspiration for their own future pathways.

This initiative is designed to reduce entry barriers and promote structured, sustainable business formation among budding entrepreneurs.

## RCOEM TBI – Techwalnut Summer Internship Program 2025 | Launched May 16, 2025

The Summer Internship Program 2025, organized by RCOEM TBI in collaboration with Techwalnut Innovations LLP, was launched on May 16, 2025, to bridge academic learning with industry-driven challenges. 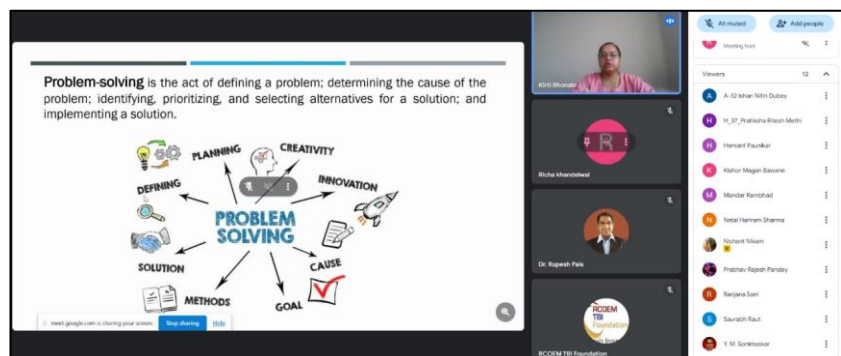
The session left participants motivated and inspired to take the next step on their entrepreneurial paths.

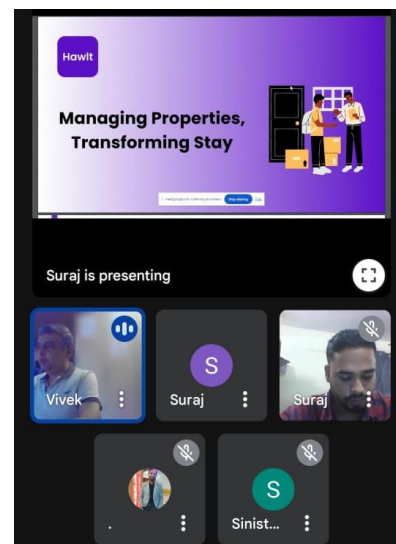
The event left attendees with valuable knowledge and fresh perspectives to support their future academic and entrepreneurial pursuits.

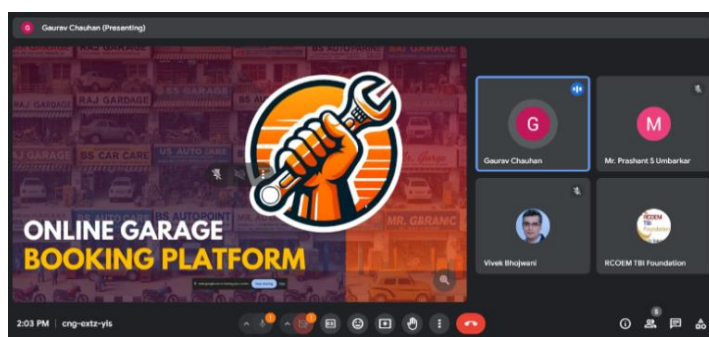
The final evaluation took place on October 24, 2024, at RCOEM TBI, where a distinguished panel of experts assessed the submitted ideas. The evaluators included Dr.

The final section included an intellectual reasoning question to help students develop impactful slogans, inspiring them to support energy-saving initiatives in daily life.

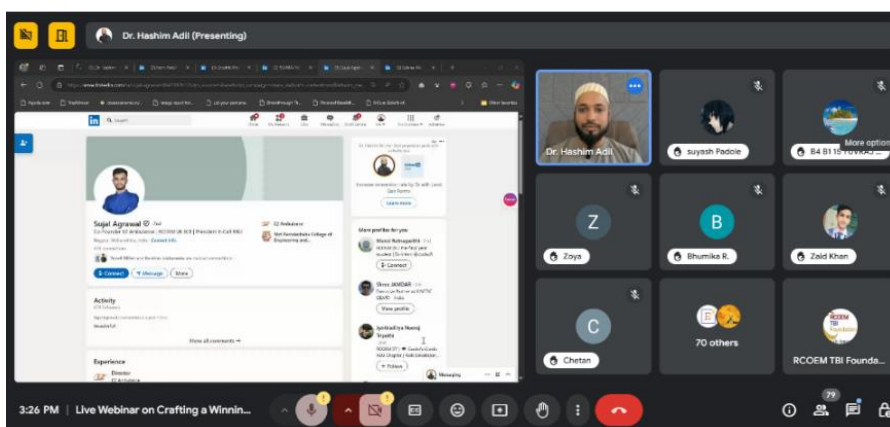


## Crafting a Winning LinkedIn Profile | December 14, 2024

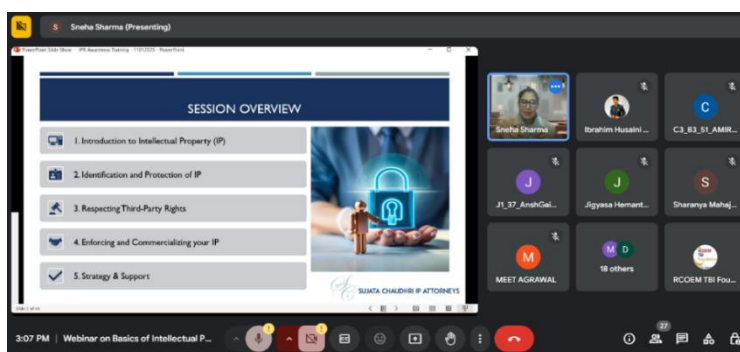
The session saw enthusiastic participation and provided attendees with practical, actionable knowledge to strengthen their entrepreneurial technology journeys.
